

Nottingham Trent University Open Day Exclusive Booking Offer - Terms and Conditions

1. Individuals who attend the Nottingham Trent University Open Day (“Event”) at Nottingham Trent University, 50 Shakespeare Street, Nottingham, NG1 4FQ, between 9:00am GMT and 20:00pm GMT on Saturday 7 March 2026 (“Event Period”) and register their details with Student Roost (the contact form is available by scanning the QR code on display at the Student Roost stall) during the Event Period will be eligible to receive a £50 Amazon e-gift card (“Gift”), subject to these terms and conditions.
2. This offer is open to new customers only who meet the eligibility criteria set out below.
3. To qualify for the Gift, an individual must:
