

University of London Housing Fair Prize Draw Terms and Conditions

1. Individuals who attend the University of London Housing Fair (“Event”) at Beveridge Hall, Macmillan Hall & Crush Hall (South Block, Ground Floor), University of London, Senate House, Malet Street, London WC1E 7HU, between 11:00am GMT and 20:00pm GMT on Thursday 5 March 2026 (“Entry Period”) and register their details with Student Roost (the contact form is available by scanning the QR code on display at the Student Roost stall) during the Entry Period will be automatically entered into a prize draw to win a £200 (two hundred pounds) Amazon e-gift card (the ‘Prize’), subject to these terms and conditions.

This offer is open to prospective new customers only, subject to meeting the eligibility criteria in paragraph 2.
